DISCOVER PROFESSORS LAKE TRAIL

THE PROFESSORS LAKE TRAIL FOLLOWS A LINEAR PARK SYSTEM FROM VICTORIA PARK ARENA ON AVONDALE BLVD. AND CONTINUES NORTH TO PROFESSORS LAKE. ALONG THIS 11 KM TRAIL, THERE ARE A SERIES OF PARKS OFFERING GREEN SPACE AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING PROFESSORS LAKE PARK, GREENBRIAR PARK, CHINGUACOUSY PARK AND VICTORIA PARK. EACH PARK HAS A RECREATION-CENTRE, EACH WITH ITS OWN UNIQUE FEATURES AND FACILITIES SUCH AS SWIMMING POOLS, PLAYGROUNDS AND SPORTS ARENAS.


This trail is truly special because it has a man-made spring-fed by the same name, Professors Lake. Containing a 26-hectare lake surrounded by 32 hectares of parkland, Professors Lake offers a wide variety of summer family activities. There are well-groomed sandy beaches and the lake can be used for windsurfing, canoeing, sailing, paddle boating, and fishing. Other activities include a water slide, beach volleyball, playgrounds and ice-skating in the winter.

The trail also features the Brampton Music Theatre, a community group theatre that has been supporting local art production and youth arts participation in Brampton for over 30 years.

Professor Lake Trail runs through Chinguacousy Park, one of Brampton's most impressive parks, where there is something for everyone. This park is home to many of Brampton's lively festivals and celebrations all year round, boasting a ski hill, a farm with petting zoo, mini golf, batting cages, greenhouse and much, much more!




PROFESSORS LAKE TRAIL in Brampton

1 | Victoria Park and Arena: The park features an arena and a soccer stadium, as well as outdoor green space.



3 | Chinguacousy Park: This park is home to many of Brampton's festivals and celebrations. The park boasts a ski hill, a farm with petting zoo, mini golf, batting cages, tennis court, splash pool, band shell and greenhouse.



5 | Greenbriar Park and Recreation Centre: The indoor amenities of the recreation centre include an arena and community rooms. The outdoor facilities consist of ball diamonds, playgrounds, soccer fields and tennis courts.



6 | Professors Lake Recreation Centre: The recreation centre features several multi-purpose recreation rooms, outdoor facilities and a rentals office for canoes, kayaks, paddleboats and water bikes.



2 | Earnscliffe Park and Recreation Centre: The indoor facilities include two sports arenas, a swimming pool, community rooms, an aerobic studio and fitness equipment. The outdoors amenities consist of ball diamonds, playgrounds, soccer fields and tennis courts.



4 | Brampton Music Theatre: The Brampton Music Theatre is a community theatre group that has been supporting local art production in Brampton for over 30 years. The project encourages local theatre production and youth arts participation.

7 | Professors Lake Beach: Professor's Lake is a, man-made, spring-fed lake surrounded by 32 hectares of parkland and offering a wide variety of summer family activities. It features well-groomed sandy beaches and is used for windsurfing, canoeing, sailing, paddle boating, and fishing. Only non-motorized boats are allowed on the water. Other activities include a waterslide, beach volleyball, playgrounds and ice-skating in the winter. Professor's Lake Trail features a scenic walking, cycling and inline-skating path that follows Brampton's park system.

LEGEND:

 **Paved Multi-use Trail**, an off-road asphalt/concrete path that may be used by pedestrians, cyclists, rollerbladers and skateboarders.

PROFESSORS LAKE TRAIL in Brampton

Length: 11 kilometres

Activities: Walking, jogging, cycling, in-line skating

Season: Year-round

Surface: Paved asphalt

Parking: Parking is available at all facility centres.

Rules/Etiquette: Dogs must be kept on a leash, and stoop and scoop by-laws apply.

Amenities: Lights, benches, and garbage bins. Washrooms are available at facility centres including: Chinguacousy Wellness Centre, Donald M. Gordon Chinguacousy Park, Earnscliffe Recreation Centre, Greenbriar Recreation Centre, James F. McCurry Victoria Park Arena, Professor's Lake Recreation, William Osler Medical Centre.
